If this **vision** calls to you, if you don't accept that big change can't happen and if you want to be part of that change, this is for you!

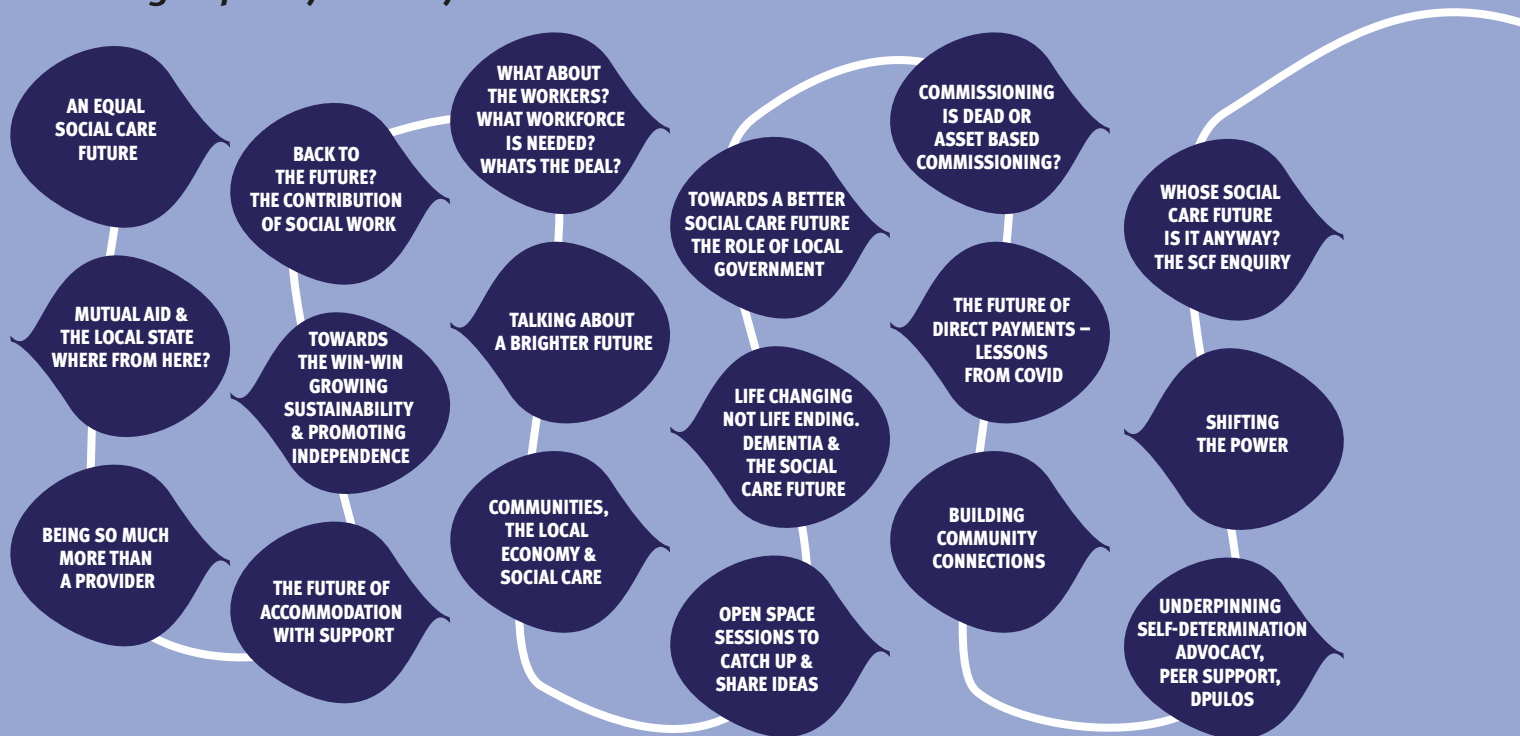
